### BUFFALO CREEK GUN CLUB MEETING MINUTES - April 10, 2001

1. The meeting was called to order at 7:05 PM.
2. A motion was made, seconded and passed to approve the March minutes.
3. **TREASURER'S REPORT**
  - The Treasurer's report showed a checking account balance of \$6387.09 and \$12,333.69 in CD's for a sum of \$18,720.68 in total assets.
  - A motion was made, seconded and passed to accept the Treasurer's report as presented.
4. **MEMBERSHIP REPORT**
  - A motion was made, seconded and passed to accept two new members in attendance: Phil Fairclaw and Dennis Montowski.
  - Dan Gabel submitted an updated membership report to the board.
  - Dues and workbond notices will be mailed to all on the membership list before the next board meeting.
  - Mike Walton reported receiving a phone request from Tom Philips for a membership packet; it will be mailed immediately.
  - A motion was made, seconded and passed to accept the Membership report as presented.
5. **NEWSLETTER REPORT**
  - No report (152 newsletters were mailed.)
6. **CMP REPORT**
  - 30 1903 rifles were sold by lottery; winners are being notified.
  - M-1 Carbines are for sale to clubs only: \$500 each. The board has considered purchasing additional carbines, but not at that price.
  - A motion was made, seconded and passed to accept the CMP report as presented.
7. **CLINIC REPORT**
  - No report.
8. **SILHOUETTE REPORT**
  - The match on Sunday, April 8<sup>th</sup>, was cancelled due to high winds. 20 able and willing shooters were blown away.
  - A motion was made, seconded and passed to accept the Silhouette report as presented.
9. **HIGHPOWER REPORT**
  - No report.
10. **JUNIOR REPORT**
  - Jim Starr is still working on the next raffle; the club's new license is expected to arrive any day, and tickets will be printed immediately thereafter.
  - A bullet order from Hornady is in the works for the Juniors.
  - Current brass and primer supplies are sufficient for this season.
  - 4 Juniors are currently attending practices at Brush: Alicia and Aubrey Trujillo, Amanda Collier, and Greg Fonseca.
  - Junior practices have resumed at Boulder Rifle Club at 4:30 on Wednesdays.

- Camp Perry billeting requests have been filed, and payments for the first night's stay must be made to Jim Starr immediately (\$10.90 per participant).
  - A motion was made, seconded and passed to accept the Junior report as presented.
11. **RANGE OFFICER'S REPORT**
- New pulleys will be installed temporarily on target #1 for testing.
  - A supply of TP will be kept in the stat house.
  - The board discussed in detail the amount of materials needed for fencing and sign work on the upcoming workday.
  - A number of suggestions were made regarding sign placement at the main gate and elsewhere, as well as for adding another gate closer to the range; the board did not vote on any of these measures.
  - A motion was made, seconded and passed to accept the Range Officer's report as presented.
12. **SMALLBORE REPORT**
- The Smallbore Winter League Annual Dinner Meeting was held on Tuesday, April 4<sup>th</sup>, at the Country Buffet restaurant in Englewood. 28 people attended, and all league participants present received awards and/or prizes. The current league officers were reelected, and the current course of fire was approved for next year. The meeting concluded a very successful season in which more new shooters and more shooters overall participated than in any of the previous 4 years.
  - A motion was made, seconded and passed to accept the Smallbore report as presented.
13. **OLD BUSINESS**
- Dan Gabel asked whether or not the 1995 version of the By-Laws is still in effect; that version is still in effect.
  - Kent Beach asked for a clarification of the .223 ammo order for the AR-15 clinic which was approved last month; after a discussion of the price and quality of a number of alternative brands, it was again agreed to order 2000 rounds of Sellier & Bellot ammunition.
  - Jim Starr and Kent Beach will complete the CMP report immediately.
  - Jim Starr and Vince Carroll still have to review some match sponsorship matters for this season.
  - Infantry Trophy Team practice dates have been established and listed on the club calendar.
  - Richard Bowman's suggestions to the board regarding the club's services and activities will remain tabled pending informal discussion between Richard and some board members.
  - The AR-15 rifle order will be sent in to the CMP on May 1<sup>st</sup>.
14. **NEW BUSINESS**
- Following discussion, a motion was made, seconded and passed to renew the club's membership in the Colorado State Shooting Association.
  - A motion was made, seconded and passed to issue membership cards to Juniors who participate at Camp Perry under the BCGC flag.
  - The Juniors own Gracey case-trimmers which are available for use by adults; contact Jim Starr.
  - The board approved without a vote the purchase of paste supplies for target preparation.
  - Richard Bowman proposes that the club offer a limited membership to clinic participants who need to be a member of a CMP affiliated club to order an M-1. Following discussion, a motion was made, seconded and passed to create a \$35.00 Provisional Annual Membership entitling the holder to receive the newsletter, but

carrying no range privileges, and providing that the Provisional Membership could be renewed as a regular 2<sup>nd</sup> year membership.

The meeting adjourned at 9:10 PM.
