## 10. RANGE OFFICER'S REPORT – Denny Conlon (RO) and Jerry Fischer (Asst RO)

- Three new cement tabletops have been installed at the short range.
- A new sign was placed at the Short Range, it displays all of the range rules.
- Fresh targets are in the stat house.

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- One sign was put up plus a sign providing direction to the pits.
- The 200-yd & 300-yd signs are up.
- A motion was made by Dean and seconded by John to accept the Range Officer's Report as presented.

#### 11. OLD BUSINESS

- Dabney is waiting on a return call from the USFS regarding possible dates from them to cut timber/sunlight our road.
- We have a new grant check from the NRA. Sam will open a new account for it.
- The Weatherby Raffle:
  - o All expenses have been approved by the Sec of State's office
  - o expected cost = \$1000; actual cost = \$1079
  - all tickets sold = \$5160 ( return a bit less than expected because 42 tickets were sold in lots of 6
  - o cleared profit = \$4081; funds must be used by 4/17/2014
  - o will be deposited in Raffle Checking account Reviewable by Dabney & Sam
  - o financial reports will be produced monthly
  - o the drawing will be May 11 at the range; Owen will video the cool shooting event
- RSO Training will be held May 10 @ the Bailey library for 5 attendees; materials must be ordered.
- Dean: SOP comments are being gathered we still need more comments. We need this doc for RSO training.
- There was some discussion re: the use of yellow rope to control where non-shooters stand at the range.

A motion was made by Owen and seconded by Dean to close Old Business.

**No Status:** A new Lease Agreement form was created and will be routed to Board Members for review.

#### 13. <u>NEW BUSINESS</u>

- Jack: investigated how other clubs advertise their financials they don't! Sam will check with bookkeeper re: how/whether non-profits advertise their financials.
- Denny: motion to make club financials available at the head table at Board meetings; seconded by Jerry; passed unanimously.
- The By-Laws are under review and suggested specific changes will be presented to the Board/Membership. In addition to typos and grammatical corrections, language will be added regarding:

- Mind-altering drugs
- Members can't use range for personal profit
- Include dues late dates & drop-dead date e.g. "due Jan 1; paid by Feb 1"
- "Limiting guest visits" discussion:
  - Much discussion re: difficulty of enforcing limits.
  - Every Newsletter should re-iterate the policy.
  - We will post a policy sign at the range, e.g. "after x visits, you must ...."
  - The guest policy will be described on the web site.
  - The guest policy will be included in the SOP.
- Gavin: the work day was awesome 14 club members dug out the entire 100-yd line.
- BCGC 5-year Plan is progressing still early planning stage. Using Google Docs.
- Insert in Newsletter a directive to always check the BCGC web-site when planning a visit, to make sure the range is accessible.
- Discussion re: new state law restricting hi-capacity magazines. Bottom Line = they must remain "continuously in your possession - they can't be loaned out because they lose their grandfathering."
- If we can ID the Mad Shotgunner via a license plate photo, he will be charged with criminal mischief.
- Owen made the motion "BCGC will continue to hold raffles to raise funds." Seconded by John; passed unanimously.
- Owen made the motion to use part of Raffle profits to make monthly payments to Dabney. Seconded by Sam; motion passed unanimously. Final Wording:
   BCGC will commence paying Dabney Crump \$250 per month, beginning May 2103, until the debt is retired. The Board will revisit the payment plan periodically, to determine if the payment should be adjusted.
- Discussion of the separation wall/berm project came down to: What can we accomplish with the \$3500 grant? Motion by John: Owen will approach the NRA about revising our grant proposal to build a 25-yard wall separating the pistol range and 100-yard range. Seconded by Sam, passed unanimously.
- The Secretary will begin tracking Board member attendance and voting at Board meetings.

The meeting adjourned at 8:44pm.
