BUFFALO CREEK GUN CLUB MEETING MINUTES February 16, 2010

3. **MAIL CALL**
 - Received: taxes, dues payments and magazines.
4. **TREASURER'S REPORT**
 - BCGC and Camp Fickes accounts are in proper order.
 - BCGC balance: \$7,700.83.
 - A motion was made, seconded and passed to accept the Treasurer's report as presented.

 - New GI web slings are available for all rifles.
 - A new First Aid kit has been placed at the range.
 - John Marx needs a generator to run the projector for a Power Point presentation at the May 22nd clinic.
 - No feedback yet from fliers distributed at recent gun shows.
 - A motion was made, seconded and passed to accept the Clinic report as presented.
9. **HIGH POWER REPORT**
 - Four Monthly Matches and the 4th of July Championships have been registered for 2010.
 - The board discussed the possibility of scheduling a 600 Any/Any match in July to replace the Prone Championship.
 - Pete Jend will explore interest in a Fall "combat Match" open to AK's, SKS's, etc.
 - A motion was made, seconded and passed to accept the High Power report as presented.
10. **JUNIORS REPORT**
 - Earl Perry has volunteered to serve as BCGC's Junior Exec.
 - A motion was made, seconded and passed to provide a complimentary membership to Earl Perry for service to the club as Junior Exec. The complimentary membership does not include annual range access.
 - A motion was made, seconded and passed to accept the Junior report as presented.

- The board discussed plans for a May 1st open range day – line officers/coaches needed; also picnic items, brats, etc.
- The board discussed giving 2009 renewals an opportunity to do extra workdays to offset the \$150 range fee.
- The locked doorknob on the Sat House will be removed.
- Discussion of a new pistol range was tabled until spring when a survey of potential sites can be conducted.
- Sam Morris suggested the installation of a signal amplifier to get a cell signal out from the range.
- The CMP will advertise BCGC's clinics.
