BUFFALO CREEK GUN CLUB MEETING MINUTES –February 17, 1999

1. The meeting was called to order by Perry Welch, President at 7:00 P.M.
2. The January meeting minutes were read and accepted
3. **TREASURER'S REPORT**
The new Treasurer, George Kruger, submitted a report for the period of Jan. 19 thru Feb 16, 1999 showing a checking account balance of \$3,415.83 and \$10,346.48 in CD's. The former Treasurer, Norm Austen, presented an analysis of income and expense for fiscal year 1998. The analysis indicated that the club lost \$1.47 per member in 1998. A general discussion ensued concerning the report. A motion was made, seconded and passed to require a proposed budget for each match sponsor and activity chairman for annual forecasting.
4. **MEMBERSHIP REPORT**
-Application for membership were received from Andrew Votaw and James Sutter. The applicants were accepted into the club by unanimous vote.
-A motion was made by the Membership Chairman, Dabney Crump, to remove the names of those members whose dues are in arrears as of March 16 from the club mailing list .

-210 newsletters printed and 205 were mailed. The next newsletter will go out prior to the April meeting as a combined February & March edition..

Mike Walton reported on the status of the Annual Dinner for Small bore members. The catering service requires a guarantee of 60 people. Prior year dinners were at a significant cost to the club. A closer study of the annual dinner will be made with a decision forthcoming by the March meeting.
9. **COWBOY REPORT**
-Ed Wisler reported that Sunrise Disposal is waiting for a call from BCGC to start trash pickup at the range. The contract call for trash pickup from April through October. Thr Range Officer, Dan Gabel, said he would call Sunrise to schedule the first pickup for April 1, 1999.
10. **CLINIC REPORT**
Mike Bevelhimer reported that the 1999 applications were being developed for the clinics and he requested authorization to rent a booth a two gun shows to pass out literature on the clinics. Authorization was withheld until Ray Barret returns from vacation. A general discussion was held concerning range safety procedures to be used at the two Garand matches scheduled for this year. Mike requested that the schedule of BCGC events for each years activities bet set by November of the previous year so that sufficient time is available to notify the various news media. A General discussion began on the configurations of M1 Garands to be allowed in the M1 Garand matches.

13. **CMP REPORT**
The CMP Coordinator, Kent Beach, reported that 7 of the club M1's have been cleaned, oiled, gauged and checked in preparation for the M1 Clinics. Mike will have the remaining rifles completed and list of replacement parts needed ready for the next meeting.

 - Dabney Crump distributed copies of the BCGC bylaws for the Board embers to review. The bylaws review will be placed on the March BOD meeting agenda.

-A motion was made, seconded and passed to set the range use fee at \$3.50 per shooter.

10. SMALL BORE REPORT

-The winter small bore season is ending.

-Sixty people would not commit to the banquet so the catered could not be contracted for. Plans for a smaller banquet will be made later.

- A motion was made, seconded and passed to wave the Garand match entry fee for Kent Beach's non-member workers.
- The Juniors raffle winners were 1st Jean Reily-300 Winchester, 2nd Antone Stuchlik - .54 caliber Hawken, 3rd Lowell Higgins - 9mm Markov.
