BUFFALO CREEK GUN CLUB MEETING MINUTES June 11, 2002

1. The meeting was called to order at 7:12PM.
2. A motion was made, seconded and passed to approve the May minutes as presented in the Newsletter.
3. **TREASURER'S REPORT**
 - No report
4. **MEMBERSHIP REPORT**
 - A motion was made, seconded and passed to accept Don Riddle, James Riddle and Bob Heyburn as new members.
 - A motion was made, seconded and passed to accept the Membership report as presented.
5. **NEWSLETTER REPORT**
 - 155 newsletters were mailed in May; 1 was returned.
 - A motion was made, seconded and passed to accept the Newsletter report as presented.
6. **CMP REPORT**
 - Camp Perry packets have been mailed.
 - 1903 Springfield sales are continuing; Kent Beach reports that most rifles are in very poor condition considering the \$350-\$500 price tags.
 - A motion was made, seconded and passed to accept the CMP report as presented.
7. **CLINIC REPORT**
 - 32 participants and 9 coaches attended the Sitting Rapid Fire Clinic on Saturday, May 25th. Besides the good turn-out, the clinic was very successful in several respects: by the end of the day, participants demonstrated significant improvement in sitting rapid fire scores and in pit service; the handloaded ammunition functioned well with only 5 of 1500 rounds returned as damaged or deficient (most were damaged by being fed from a defective magazine); and, finally, the club made a net profit of more than \$800 on the event.
 - A motion was made, seconded and passed to accept the Clinic report as presented.
8. **SILHOUETTE REPORT**
 - No report
9. **HIGHPOWER REPORT**
 - The Spring Match, on Sunday the 9th, had 36 competitors who had to cope with the high winds that blew up the Hayman fire. Smoke clouds grew ominously all day on the southern horizon and gave shooters plenty to talk about between relays.
 - Stewart Leach will turn in receipts for the Anniversary Match next week.
 - Vince Carroll reports that the matches this year have been very profitable for the club, in part because the awards schedule has been well-regulated under Vince's supervision.
 - The annual Calendar Party, a planning meeting for regional match directors, was held on June 1st. BCGC, BRC, CRC and CSSA were represented by Vince Carroll, Mike Walton, Jerry Davidson, Bob Zamora and Joe Jordan; match directors from Orchard Mesa in Grand Junction, Weld County Fish & Wildlife Assoc. in Ault, and the Cheyenne Rifle & Pistol Club were not present, but all sent detailed plans to be considered. The group agreed upon a 2003 High Power calendar which features a minimum number of conflicts for match dates among clubs in the region.
 - A motion was made, seconded and passed to accept the High Power report as presented.

10. **JUNIOR REPORT**

- Many clubs in the state now have Junior HP shooters--all Juniors must indicate their club affiliation if they are traveling to Camp Perry with the Colorado team.
- Jim Starr is preparing a list of names and arrival dates for those traveling to Camp Perry.
- Jim Starr has the raffle program under way; he will draw the \$2000 allotted to Juniors to use as seed money for the raffle.
- A motion was made, seconded and passed to accept the Junior report as presented.

11. **RANGE OFFICER'S REPORT**

- A new supply of target pasters is now available: Jim Starr will take care of storing and distributing them as needed.
- Dan Gabel needs dimensions of the roof above the stat house porch for the new steel roof.
- Steve Benninghoven spoke with Mike Bevelhimer about the roof over the small target house; he does not recommend using steel.
- The new target carrier pulleys are functioning smoothly, but one pulley assembly came loose during the Spring Match. Dan Gabel is aware of the problem and says it will be fixed as soon as possible.
- A supply of 20 penny nails is needed for target retainers; many are missing or badly bent.
- Sheetrock shims are needed to reinforce the targets; this will eliminate the problem of wind tearing targets from the frames as happened during the Spring Match.
- Mike Bevelhimer has made repairs to the main gate.
- A motion was made, seconded and passed to accept the Range Officer's report as presented.

12. **SMALLBORE REPORT**

- No report.

13. **OLD BUSINESS**

- A motion was made, seconded and passed to appoint Cary Walker to the board as Club Archivist.
- The board discussed the need for improved record keeping. All members are asked to turn over all club documents to Cary Walker. He will begin classifying and making a digital listing all club records.

14. **NEW BUSINESS**

- Mike Bevelhimer stressed the importance of having a correct club calendar published in each edition of the Newsletter.
- There has been a reduction in the amount of range work done recently and also a reduction in the number of work-day participants. The board will compile a list of jobs to be done and publish it in the next Newsletter.
- The Standing Slow Fire Clinic scheduled for Saturday, June 15th has been cancelled. The clinic will be rescheduled after the Hayman fire is contained.
- The Summer Match scheduled for Sunday, June 23rd has been rescheduled for Sunday, July 7th.
- The State High Power Rifle Championships scheduled for June 28th, 29th and 30th will still be held on those dates, **but at the Colorado Rifle Club**. Jim Starr is still running the match. The board thanks the officers of CRC for assisting the club in transferring the location of these important matches.

The meeting adjourned at 9:25 PM.
