BUFFALO CREEK GUN CLUB MEETING MINUTES JUNE 10, 2003

1. The meeting was called to order at 7:14PM.
2. A motion was made, seconded and passed to approve the May minutes as presented in the Newsletter.
3. **TREASURER'S REPORT**
 - The club's checking account balance is \$24,737.38. \$5629.00 of income has been recorded since last month, \$2900 of it from the clinics.
 - \$4130.00 was paid to Shawn McKenna for the purchase of 7 Rock River match grade AR-15 uppers.
 - A motion was made, seconded and passed to accept the Treasurer's report as presented.
4. **MEMBERSHIP REPORT**
 - A motion was made, seconded and passed to accept Jim Claxton, Bill Zollinger and Joel Brandt as new members. Joel Claxton was present.
 - 75% of the members have renewed their memberships.
 - A motion was made, seconded and passed to accept the Membership report as presented.
5. **NEWSLETTER REPORT**
 - 184 newsletters were sent out, and 2 returned, one for an address error, which has been since corrected.
 - A motion was made, seconded and passed to accept the Newsletter report as presented.
6. **ARMORER'S REPORT**
 - 7 Rock River AR-15 lowers have been ordered through Steve Work at \$240 each. These will be matched to the uppers ordered from Shawn McKenna.
 - Kent Beach will investigate price and quality of rifle cases available for the 7 new rifles.
 - The CMP has mailed out the Camp Perry registration packets.
 - A motion was made, seconded and passed to accept the CMP report as presented.
7. **CLINIC REPORT**
 - 36 have signed up for the Standing Slow Fire Clinic; preparations will be made to accommodate at least 50.
 - Mike Walton is seeking 2 individuals to take over as Clinic Execs next year.
 - A motion was made, seconded and passed to accept the Clinic report as presented.
8. **SILHOUETTE REPORT**
 - The match on June 8th drew a very small number of shooters. Bob Snyder and Steve Hawks were the match winners.
 - A motion was made, seconded and passed to accept the Silhouette report as presented.
9. **HIGHPOWER REPORT**
 - 314 championship flyers were sent out. The board discussed steps to expand and cull the statewide mailing list being maintained by Heidi Bickel.
 - Stewart Leach has not yet turned in the fees from the Anniversary Match.

- Vince Carroll has prepared all the materials for the Summer Match to be run by Tom Crist.
 - Vince Carroll will resign his post as High Power Exec on September 8th after the Fall Match, in order to spend more time with his family. The board commends Vince for restoring order to the High Power program. He has established new policies, clarified procedures and created effective documentation to guide match directors, all steps which have improved the conduct of matches and boosted turnout. Well done Vince!
 - The first official Colorado Team Practice for Camp Perry was held on May 31st with a good turnout from coaches and juniors from as far away as Grand Junction.
 - A motion was made, seconded and passed to charge the Camp Perry Exex's travel, housing and meal expenses to the High Power account.
 - Heidi Bickel received a \$500.00 advance to cover airfare and car rental expenses for Camp Perry.
 - A motion was made, seconded and passed to allow \$50.00 in food expenses for each official team practice.
 - Volunteer stat officers are still needed for the Regional Matches coming up on the July 4th weekend; contact Jim Starr if interested in earning the work-bond credit.
 - A motion was made, seconded and passed to accept the High Power report as presented.
10. **JUNIOR REPORT**
- The raffle is going well as returns are coming in.
 - Jim Starr requested and received permission to send raffle tickets to new BCGC members.
 - Jim Starr requested target supplies for the juniors to use when practicing at different ranges.
 - A motion was made, seconded and passed to accept the Junior
11. **RANGE OFFICER'S REPORT**
- On June 28th the work-party will repair the number boards in front of targets 4, 5 and 6, clean up the 500 yard firing points, and repair ropes on the flagpoles.
 - The metal is ready for the stat house roof.
 - BCGC now has a Federal Road Permit, which is in force through 2012. The club will be charged \$126.08 annually for the permit. With the permit the Forest Service has included 7 pages of instructions for maintaining the road.
 - Jeff Monroe donated a gas BBQ grill to the club.
 - A motion was made, seconded and passed to accept the Range Officer's report.

14. **NEW BUSINESS**
