BUFFALO CREEK GUN CLUB MEETING MINUTES JUNE 21, 2011

- 1. The monthly board meeting was called to order at 6:05 pm by the president.
- 2. MAIL CALL
 - No report
- 3. TREASURER'S REPORT.
 - BCGC and Camp Fickes accounts are in proper order.
 - A motion was made, seconded and passed to accept the Treasurer's report as presented

4. **MEMBERSHIP REPORT**

- Membership applications were received from Matt Smola and Jim Madere. They summarized their shooting experience and explained their reasons for wanting to join the club. A motion was made, seconded and passed to accept them as new members.
- A motion was made, seconded and passed to accept the Membership report as presented

5. **NEWSLETTER REPORT**

- The newsletter is on schedule with 112 electronic and six paper newsletters sent in May.
- A motion was made, seconded and passed to accept the Newsletter report as presented

6. **ARMORER'S REPORT**

- All of the club AR 15 and 22 rifles are accounted for.
- The AR's need cleaning before they are put away for the season.
- A motion was made, seconded and passed to accept the Armorer's report as presented.

7. CLINIC REPORT

- The June 4 clinic was great had 3 volunteers take over the class of 28. Nick Patch and Doug Ransom, with Ron Burgy helping, taught the class. Since the weather wasn't a concern the school circle went longer than normal. We finished firing about 1700 with 3 relays firing 55 rnds per shooter. We were short on coaches, but those there did an outstanding job, with some putting in a 10 hr day. These instructors and coaches are very experienced and could easily find other things to do.
- The June 18 clinic had 17 participants. Several cancelled or didn't show. From phone calls I received, the word "advanced clinic" apparently was intimidating. It should be deleted in future. We also had 12 volunteers of whom 9 were coaches. The other 3 helped with cooking, range work, or delivering and picking up rifles. Of the 12 volunteers, only 4 are BCGC members! This was another outstanding clinic in which the term "Class By Jars" was coined, thanks to Doug Ransom. Nick Patch (USMCR) and Doug (MSgt, USMC, ret) did the classroom portion. Marines love their rifles, and are passionate about their rifle. This is fact. It's true now and has been for 235 years. So it's just natural for a Marine's passion to flow when we teach others basic marksmanship. You won't see as much enthusiasm or dedication amongst others, and it passes on to the students. The clinic finished with grilled hot dogs (thanks Sheila!). For those unfamiliar with these clinics, they're not just for beginners. There's a lot of

material covered-more than can be digested in 1 day, so notes are advisable. Even NRA High Masters or other very experienced shooters would learn new things.

A motion was made, seconded and passed to accept the Clinic report as presented

8. HIGH POWER REPORT

- The Spring match was held June 6th. We had a good turnout of 34 shooters including some first time competitors. A big thanks to Steve Howard for making the effort t50 run the match. Steve was up and on the road at 3:30AM to make the drive in from the western slope. Steve ran a great match! \$795.00 was taken in, \$154.00 was given back in prizes, \$148.50 went to the NRA and the balance was sent to the BCGC treasurer.
- The request for a Match Director replacement for the July 24th State Prone Championship was filled by George DeTar. We need to encourage new Match Directors and it is great to see George step up.
- A discussion was held regarding how to handle calling the July 4th matches. Tom Crist and Dave Sullivan have offered to call the match by staying on the line rather than doubling up pullers in the pits. This should lend more continuity to the match, while allowing everyone that wants to shoot the chance to compete. Additional help will be needed to run stats during the match. - John Downing reported that he is preparing a procedural plan and hopes to have the junior program up and running soon.

- Dan Gable replaced the pulleys and ropes on the 200 and 300-yard lines.
