BUFFALO CREEK GUN CLUB MEETING MINUTES March 11, 2003

- The club's checking account balance is \$20, 654.29. The Treasurer also has \$1122.00 in uncashed checks. Over the last three months the club has recorded a net income of \$729.94 from receipts of \$4049.00.
- The club's bank statements are now arriving at the new Post Office box.
- The Treasurer expects to present a printed 1st quarter report at the next meeting.
- A motion was made, seconded and passed to accept the Treasurer's report as presented.

4. **MEMBERSHIP REPORT**

- A motion was made, seconded and passed to accept Bill Andrle and Brian Reck, who were present, and E.H. Vanover and Donald Klein as new members.
- Dan Gabel has gotten calls about the failure to announce work-party in advance.
- A motion was made, seconded and passed to accept the Membership report as presented.

5. **NEWSLETTER REPORT**

- 179 newsletters were sent out; none were returned.
- Individual notices about overdue work-bonds and dues were sent out with the newsletter.
- A motion was made, seconded and passed to accept the Newsletter report as presented.

6. **CMP REPORT**

- The CMP has recently mailed a catalog of CMP products.
- .30/06 Garand ammo produced by Federal is now available for sale in 500 round lots for \$197.00 and \$16.57 shipping.
- Kent Beach has not received any requests from members for an ammo purchase.
- .30 Ball ammo will be for sale at the BCGC table at the Tanner Gun Show on April 22-27.
- A motion was made, seconded and passed to accept the CMP report as presented.

- A half dozen or more persons have signed up for all four of this season's clinics.
- Ray Barrett will bring clinic fliers to the next meeting; board members will distribute them to local gun-shops.
- The fired brass from last year's clinics has been reprocessed.
- A motion was made, seconded and passed to accept the Clinic report as presented.

9. **HIGHPOWER REPORT**

- Vince Carroll has mailed out BCGC match forms.
- A new championship match mailing is in the works.

- David Karcher has contacted Jim Starr about arranging for the Marine Reserve team resuming practices at BCGC during the week before the Regional Championships. Jim will get confirmation in the next 30 days.

- A motion was made, seconded and passed to accept the Junior report as presented.

- The first work-party is scheduled for Saturday, April 5th beginning at 8:00 AM. April 26th will be the alternate date.

- Darrel Evig and Stuart Behrens will shoot grades for the proposed 100 yard firing point fill before March 15th and deliver the plans to the Forest Service.

- A motion was made, seconded and passed to accept the Range Officer's report.

- The Winter League will conclude the season at the end of the month. The annual dinner/meeting is scheduled for 6:30PM Wednesday, April 2nd at the Country Buffet in Phar-Mor Plaza in Englewood.

4. High Power Service Rifle Marksmanship Clinic Schedule

Buffalo Creek Gun Club will be hosting High Power rifle clinics throughout the summer of 2003. These clinics have been designed to cover all aspects of High Power Service Rifle competition shooting. The clinics will each include an informative lecture on safety, handling, and function of the AR15 rifle. At the close of the day participants will learn to field strip and clean the AR15. Each event will focus on one of the four positions used when shooting in competition, according to the following schedule:

Sat. May 10, 2003: 200 yard SITTING RAPID FIRE

Sat. June 14, 2003: 200 yard STANDING SLOW FIRE

Sat. July 12, 2003: 300 yard PRONE RAPID FIRE

Sat. Sept. 6, 2003: 600 yard PRONE SLOW FIRE

Buffalo Creek Gun Club will furnish "National Match Grade" AR15 rifles and ammunition for these clinics. The price for these clinics is \$45.00 each or \$150.00 for the series of four (Pre-paid), ammunition included. (Juniors \$30 each/\$100 series) If you wish to be instructed using your own service rifle, you will be allowed to do so. However, BCGC will only be able to furnish ammunition for those rifles using the .30-06 or .223 cartridge. Any other rifles will require you to furnish your own ammunition.
