8. NEWSLETTER REPORT

Two hundred newsletters were printed and mailed in April to members of record as of January 1, 1997. The new membership list will be used starting with the May mailing.

9. COWBOY'S REPORT

The April work party and the first match were snowed out. The work party is now scheduled to coincide with the BCGC work party on May 3 and 4. The first Match will be on May 10.

10. SMALL BORE REPORT

A lengthy discussion was held on the decline of the winter league and how it might be revitalized. Mike Walton will keep the Board apprised of any revitalization actions that might be taken.

11. JUNIORS REPORT

The seasoned opened Wednesday with practices at the Boulder Rifle Club. All club members are invited to practice with the Juniors every Wednesday from 4:30 to dark. Hornady is continuing to support the Juniors with jackets, tee shirts and 230 pounds of 180 grain bullets.

12. OLD BUSINESS

- The CSSA agreed to the purchase from the DCM by BCGC of the 17 M1's and 10 Kimbers now under their control. A payment schedule of 1/3 now, 1/3 in October and 1/3 in March 1998 was proposed. A motion was made, seconded and passed to follow this payment schedule.
- The Board was informed that the four M1's being rebarreled by Don McCoy will come in significantly under budget. A motion was made, seconded and passed to use the surplus funds to purchase the needed accessories for these rifles so long as the total does not exceed the original appropriation.
- A cook is needed for the May work party.
- The gas bottles need to be filled.
- 400 flyers need to be printed for the gun show.

13. NEW BUSINESS

- Mike Bogard was authorized to prepare a letter for the newsletter concerning the purchase of Hornady (any caliber) and National Match bullets by club members.
- Jim Starr will follow up with the DCM/CMP on the price of the National match bullets.
- Ray Barrett will provide the prices of Kreiger barrels to Mike Bogard for an order open to club members at a significant discount.
- Jim Starr will prepare a Thank You letter for the donations to the Juniors for publication in the news letter.
- The DCM/CMP is publishing a monthly newsletter. This will be reprinted in the BCGC newsletter as space is available.
