- There was a discussion of the concept of waiving a member's workbond in recognition of his contributions/responsibilities for another gun club; the idea was unanimously rejected in an informal vote.

- A motion was made, seconded and passed to accept the Membership report as presented.

5. NEWSLETTER REPORT
