BUFFALO CREEK GUN CLUB MEETING MINUTES November 12, 2002

1. The meeting was called to order at 7:14PM.
2. A motion was made, seconded and passed to approve the September minutes as presented in the Newsletter.
3. **TREASURER'S REPORT**
 - The checking account contains \$20, 907.72; the club's total assets amount to \$22, 923.45.
 - A motion was made, seconded and passed to accept the Treasurer's report as presented.
4. **MEMBERSHIP REPORT**
 - A motion was made, seconded and passed to accept Tom Korchunoff, Jon Coppenbarger, Steve Smith and Matt Hess as new members; all were present at the meeting.
 - A second motion was made, seconded and passed to accept law enforcement officers Troy Smith and Scott Hughes as new members; neither was present at the meeting.
 - A motion was made, seconded and passed to accept the Membership report as presented.
5. **NEWSLETTER REPORT**
 - 163 newsletters were sent out; one was returned.
 - A motion was made, seconded and passed to accept the Newsletter report as presented.
6. **CMP REPORT**
 - "The good ol' days is gone."--Kent Beach
 - No large stocks of M2 Ball remain, and the Danish ammo is gone.
 - '03 Springfields are mostly gone.
 - "You're being hosed." --Kent Beach, regarding current CMP ads for acquiring M-1's.

 - A motion was made, seconded and passed to accept the CMP report as presented.
7. **CLINIC REPORT**
 - No report.
8. **SILHOUETTE REPORT**
 - The Teddy Roosevelt Match, held at Greenmill Sportsman's Club in July, had 15 participants. Chuck McAbery won Standard Rifle class; Aaron Routh Hunting Rifle class.
 - The September 15th match at BCGC drew 7 competitors; Steve Hawks won in both rifle classifications.
 - A motion was made, seconded and passed to accept the Silhouette report as presented.
9. **HIGHPOWER REPORT**
 - No report.
10. **JUNIOR REPORT**
 - No report.
11. **RANGE OFFICER'S REPORT**
 - 8 or 9 members showed up for the September workday.
 - A steel roof was installed over the Stat House porch, bushes were trimmed, the lower road fence on the northeast side of the range was repaired, and target frames were repaired.
 - Mike Bevelhimer wants to organize a wood-cutting day on the range as the club has permission from the Forest Service to clear all scrub ponderosa on the range floor.
 - Frank McKeon has put up the new range warning signs.
 - A motion was made, seconded and passed to accept the Range Officer's report.

12. **SMALLBORE REPORT**

- Smallbore Winter League has 42 participants at the end of the 5th week of record shooting.
- A motion was made, seconded and passed to accept the Smallbore report as presented.

13. **OLD BUSINESS**

- In the spring any of the club's M2 Ball that has not been sold to members will be offered at gunshows for .30/round.
- The AR-15 lease agreement form has been completed.
- No progress has been made in recovering insurance money for the club's stolen AR-15.

14. **NEW BUSINESS**

- Mike Bevelhimer has the club's AR-15 rifles, but he has no insurance rider to cover them.
- Richard Bowman will contact the National Shooting Sports Foundation about insurance.
- Ads for the 2003 AR-15 clinics need to be prepared for the December gunshhows.
- Ray Barrett will contact John Pentycofe about Colorado Springs gunshows. Ray will also set up a table at a Pueblo gunshow.
- Mike Bevelhimer will send out a state-of-the-club letter to the membership this month. Please read it.
- Mike Bevelhimer proposed the creation of a 100 yard firing point with three positions for targets 13, 14 and 15. After discussion the board agreed, and plans were discussed to get the job done before spring.
- The board discussed and agreed upon changes in the Range Operation Rules suggested by Mike Bevelhimer. Rule 6 is amended to say, "Firing shall be done downrange into the appropriate impact area...and at targets mounted in permanent frames." In addition, the following will be added to Rule 6: "All short range pistol, shotgun and muzzleloading shooting must be done behind the target pits and into the main impact berm." Rule 12 will be changed by adding the following: "Members shall be responsible for the conduct of their guests."
- Appropriate signs relative to these rule changes will be placed on the range.
- Colorado Police Academy leased the range for 2 days in November; some members showed up and were asked to leave. This caused some troubles, which were resolved, but which could have been avoided. A signed lease agreement will be prepared specifying all terms of future leases. A standardized lease invoice will also be created.
- Richard Bowman asked that the club allow the Boy Scouts to use the range in early September of 2003. The board will research the possibility of doing so.
- New member Steve Smith would like to lease the range for a Jim Owens Advanced High Power clinic. Steve expects 12-18 participants. The board will vote after Mike Walton researches the calendar opportunities.

The meeting adjourned at 9:04 PM.
