BUFFALO CREEK GUN CLUB MEETING MINUTES October 14, 2003

- 1. The meeting was called to order at 7:24PM.
- 2. A motion was made, seconded and passed to approve the September minutes as presented in the Newsletter.

- A motion was made, seconded and passed to accept the Treasurer's report as presented.

4. MEMBERSHIP REPORT

- A motion was made, seconded and passed to accept Richard McFadden, "Kit" Kitteridge, Dennis Kazmierzak, Paul Johnson, Jeff Wigton, Geoff Peters and Art Zeiss as new members.
- Cary Walker sent in a \$50 workbond for 2003.
- A motion was made, seconded and passed to accept the Membership report as presented.

5. **NEWSLETTER REPORT**

- 193 newsletters were sent out in September; none returned.
- A motion was made, seconded and passed to accept the Newsletter report as presented.

6. **ARMORER'S REPORT**

- Thanks to Fred Sortwell for several web-slings donated for use on club AR's.
- Kent Beach reports that rust preventative cleaning has been done on all rifles used in the rainy September clinic..
- All club rifles still need a more thorough cleaning before next season.
- WORKBOND OPPORTUNITY: Contact Kent Beach about helping with rifle cleaning.
- Cleaning supplies need to be reordered.
- Gun cases have been ordered from Sportsman's Warehouse.
- Jon Coppenbarger will order additional web-slings.
- Jon Coppenbarger has acquired 10 20 round magazines for the club AR's. (The mags will be spray-painted brightly to discourage theft, as 4 mags were missing after this summer's clinics.)
- The 2003 CMP report has been submitted.
- The one club rifle on lease will be either sold or retrieved from the person leasing it.
- A motion was made, seconded and passed to accept the Armorer's report as presented.

7. CLINIC REPORT

- In November Mike Walton will begin loading ammo for the 2004 clinics.
- New member volunteers are needed to run the clinics in 2004. Positions for Clinic Executive, Line Officer and Pitt Officer are open.
- A motion was made, seconded and passed to accept the Clinic report as presented.

9. **HIGH POWER REPORT**

- High Power information and materials from Vince Carroll have been turned over to Jon Coppenbarger.
- All matches for 2004 have sponsors.
- One High Power mailing is planned for 2004. Jon Coppenbarger will coordinate with Jim Starr, Heidi Bickel and Mike Walton on updating the mailing list.
- A 2004 High Power match calendar is being prepared and will be available at the November board meeting.
- Rats ate part of 2 range flags; Jim Starr is having them repaired.

- Steve Smith is the new High Power Match Director for the Frontier Sportsman's Club in Colorado Springs. He will run at least 2 Approved matches in 2004.
- The .30 Cal Only match on October 5th was a success with 11 shooters participating. All expressed enthusiasm for continuing the match next year and registering it as a championship.
- A motion was made, seconded and passed to accept the High Power report as presented.

10. **JUNIOR REPORT**

- Jim Starr reports that there are currently no scheduled Junior practices and few Juniors are participating in matches. School!
- A motion was made, seconded and passed to accept the Junior report as presented.

11. RANGE OFFICER'S REPORT

- 8 members showed up for the workday on September 27th.
- Cardboard backings on some targets were replaced; the steel roof was repaired on the small target house (more steel has been ordered to finish the job; and some maintenance work was done on number boards in front of targets.

- The dumpster has been moved to the south side of the parking lot to a spot less accessible to bears.
- A motion was made, seconded and passed to accept the Range Officer's report.

- The Winter League is up and running with record shots fired in the first week of October. 35 shooters are participating so far at the Cherry Creek Gun Club and Boulder Rifle Club ranges.
- 4 rifles are available to be checked out to new Winter League participants.
