

Range Safety Kit

Shown below is a kit put together by an RSO at BCGC. This is not official, but something they assembled since our range is remote and in the event of an emergency an RSO may be stuck outdoors assisting someone until help arrives. This is a small basic kit that all fits in a zippered pouch and fits in a range bag. It allows the RSO to have their own tools at their fingertips and be self-reliant in the event of an extended emergency. RSOs can begin with this and add to or subtract items as desired.

Paper and pen

Address and coordinates of BCGC

Phone number to rescue, fire and Jeffco Sheriff

Directions to and from Camp Fickes

List of things to include in information for dispatcher when making a rescue call (from the NRA RSO book).

Headlamp

Knife

Schrade tool

Small First aid kit - gloves, band-aids, benadryl, etc.

Umbrella - shelter from wind, rain, hail, sun

Space blanket - shelter, warmth, protection

Duct tape

Kleenex, ziploc and hand sanitizer

Kerchief / Bandana - multiple uses,

Water

Snack

Rain jacket with hood - in case RSO is caught out in elements assisting an injured shooter/guest
