Rimfire Benchrest at Colorado Rifle Club

The Colorado Rifle Club will again be hosting Rimfire Benchrest matches in 2023. The matches at Colorado Rifle Club (CRC) will follow the same rules and rifle classification as the matches currently held at Buffalo Creek Gun Club, Inc. (BCGC). Graciously, JP & Del have allowed us to utilize the materials they have created. Our goal is to create a uniform rimfire benchrest competition throughout the Front Range. The matches will be held on the Schuetzen range at CRC.

The Colorado Rifle Club was founded in 1925 by members of the Denver Rifle Club which was formed in 1893. The original club was located at Morrison Road and Kipling. That location closed in 1980 because of encroaching development. The club relocated in 1989 and is currently situated on 2560 acres outside of Byers, Co.

Scheutzen Range Accommodations

The Scheutzen range has a covered firing line with 18, 50-yard shooting positions. Each is equipped with a concrete bench and adjustable stool.

Match Fees

\$10.00 CRC members and \$20.00 for non-members (non-members are required to complete an electronic liability waiver, available on the crci.org website) The liability waiver is good for the calendar year. The match fee entitles a competitor to shoot two rifle classes per match.

Match Schedule

7:30 AM setup and bench assignments

Match specific range safety/protocol will be given to all shooters.
8:00 AM start time (match duration approximately 2.5 hours)

An additional five- minute sighting session will precede the first of the two stages. A time for competitors to clean their rifles is permitted between stages

after a Cold Range is called.

A 15-minute protest period begins after all targets are scored and posted.

Any shooter may call for a protest related to their target(s) only.

The second relay will begin immediately after the competitors have completed

all their shots for record.

Rifle Classifications

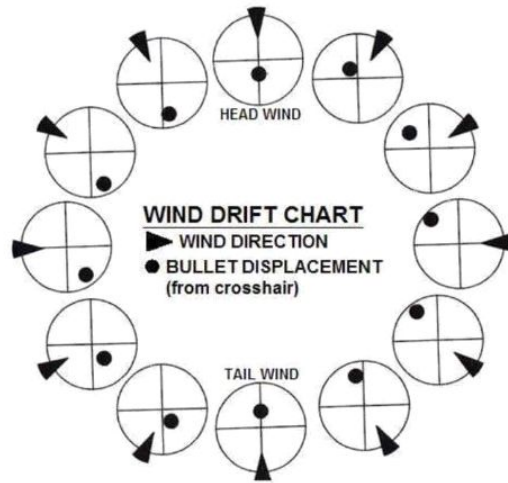
CRC will utilize the same classifications as established by JP and Del of Buffalo Creek Gun Club, Inc. Details can be found on the BCGC website (bcgc.us) .22 Rimfire Benchrest

This last year shooting at BCGC, we experienced some favorable wind conditions. We anticipate with the early start times at CRC, we can avoid the

worst of the inevitable winds. Historically, the wind in Byers blows at an average speed of 10 – 16 mph. The windiest month is April, with an average

wind speed of 15.7 mph. The calmest month is July, with an average wind

speed of 12.7 mph. Wind Flags are highly recommended!
