

Steel Challenge (SC)

Welcome to BCGC SC

Pre-registration is required for all matches via Practiscore.

- Go to practiscore.com and create a free Practiscore account.
- Click the tab **Match** and then enter **BCGC** in the search field.
- Choose the BCGC match for which you want to register.

SC matches are run with a **COLD RANGE**. All firearms must be unloaded unless under the **direct supervision** of a Safety Officer (SO).

Location, Days, Times, and Cost

- Always check the Schedule of Events on the BCGC website for updates or changes prior to coming to the range.
- SC matches are held on the Jim Starr Long Range **1st Thursday** of every month, and **3rd Saturday** of the odd months (January, March, May, July, September, November).
 - **8:00 am Setup and Check-in**
 - **8:15 am New Competitor Meeting** (Safety and SC Basics)
 - **9:00 am Safety Briefing**
 - **Shots down range after the Safety Briefing**
- Cost is \$10 for BCGC members, \$20 for non-members

Participants and Equipment

- Speed, Accuracy, Competition and Fun are the hallmarks of a **Steel Challenge** match both for beginners and experienced shooters.
- SC matches are open to both BCGC members and to non-members. New SC Competitors are always welcome!
- SC Competitors who have not previously participated in a **BCGC** SC match are required to attend the New Competitor Meeting in order to participate in the match.
- BCGC SC Matches typically have 4 stages (2 standard & 2 outlaw). Each stage will require 25 rounds minimum. Bring extra rounds as needed (150-200 rounds is recommended).
- Ammunition: Minimum cartridge for centerfire competitions is (38 Special/9mm). Rimfire firearms must use .22 Long Rifle (.22LR) cartridges only. Maximum velocity is 1,600 ft/sec.
- A Holster is required for the centerfire handgun competitors. Collapsible holsters and Serpa style holsters are not allowed. Competitors using .22LR handguns are not allowed to draw from the holster, but may use a holster instead of a handgun case.
- Five magazines are recommended, depending on capacity of magazines.
- Eye Protection and Hearing Protection are mandatory.
- Other items to bring are sun screen, water, snacks/lunch, rain gear, folding chair.
